## Brief Project Description

"Together We Are Empowered", is a school-wide (1st-6th grade) community mural where students will learn artistic techniques and concepts and then apply them to an on-site school mural project.

The mural will have the school colors painted in the back ground and the words "Together We Are Empowered" painted at the top. The lower part of the mural will have the hand prints of all participating students over the school colors. The hand prints will be multi-colored.

The intent of the project is for students to consider their journey at John Sloat Elementary. The impress the importance of students supporting and encouraging one another. To make a visually beautiful and lasting imprint students will carry for the rest of their lives.

## Scope of Work

## Lesson 1 (In-classroom Grades 1-6)

Each grade receives a one hour lesson about color, art tools use, composition, group collaborative art and mural making. Each lessons is adjusted to each grade level.

During the in-classroom lessons each student will practice using tempura paints, a brush and paper to practice making their hand prints.

Lessons will occur 2 hours/day total 4 hours/wk. 4 classrooms /wk
Artist will need 30 minute set up and take down.

## Lesson 2 (Mural Work Grades TK-6, SDC)

Each class will have a 1 hour mural class where students will bring their sample prints to the mural and consider which handprint they would like on the wall, where and why.

Students will then be directed to a staged paint table where they will paint the palm of their hands and add the hand print to the mural. Lower grades will work with limited color palette. Color palette will increase in choice for upper grades.

Two assistants will be needed to help students: put on protective aprons, apply paint to hands and press palm on wall. Wash hands and and clean up.

Artist will need 30 minutes set up and take down.
*TK, K, SDC classes will include paintbrush lesson, how to apply paint to hand and press hand to wall.

## Mural completion

Graffiti cleaning and repair supplies and instructions will be included.
Upon completion of of the mural artist will be available for future questions and concerns in regards to mural care and maintenance.

## Project Prepration

Discuss logistics of mural location with CLARA center and John Sloat include:
Mural size
Wall surface and preparation
If outdoors, mural face direction (north, south...)
Artist access
Surrounding mural staging
Storage of mural supplies and equipment.
Clean-up (access to sink)/garbage
Confirm location and size of John Sloat mural
Review supply list and confirm what John Sloat can provide
Final approval funding through CLARA center or other source
